## **Ukey Hooky; Core Activities**

- 1. **Regular Group Meet ups:** The foundation of Ukey Hooky is to provide opportunities for regular group meet ups, where participants can come together with other Ukulele enthusiasts for regular Strumalongs and jam sessions. Opportunities will also be available for beginners and new players to get involved.
- 2. Accessible to Everyone: Ukey Hooky recognise that not everyone who would like to play the Ukulele will be able to come along to our group Strumalongs. Some people may not be able to leave their homes, are uncomfortable in groups or when meeting new people, or do not live in the area. So, we provide a range of alternative options through the website, including a complete beginner's course, downloadable song books, and other useful hints and tips which are available as part of an Annual Membership fee.
- 3. **Public Performances:** Ukey Hooky will provide opportunities for group members to perform for the public at events, and visit venues to perform. This may include Care Home, local fayres and other similar public events. We will also organise activities and events to bring together other Ukulele groups and performers to establish connections and perform together.
- 4. **Group and Individual Development.** Ukey Hooky will provide opportunities for group members to become actively involved in Workshop Facilitation and other similar activities to enable participants to gain experience and develop leadership skills. Some activities may require participants to attend participatory sessions, or training.
